Judging for the following classes is held for the Breed Origin Categories of : Tropical, European & British

1. Bull under 12 months.
2. Bull 12 months & under 18 months.
- Junior Champion Bull & Reserve Junior Champion Bull**
3. Bull 18 months & under 24 months,
4. Bull over 24 months.
- Senior Champion Bull & Reserve Senior Champion Bull**
5. Heifer under 12 months.
6. Heifer 12 months & under 18 months.
- Junior Champion Heifer & Reserve Junior Champion Heifer**

7. Female 18 months & under 24 months
8. Female over 24 months.
- Senior Champion Heifer & Reserve Senior Champion Heifer**
9. Breeders Group: three animals, both sexes to be presented, all 12 months and under 48 months. Animals must be owned and bred by the exhibitor. All animals must be entered in the general classes.
10. Bucket fed calf: 1 month to 6 months. Not necessarily purebred.
11. Led Steer competition: not necessarily purebred-milk tooth (light weight & heavy weight).

Regulations for Stud Beef Cattle & Stud Dexter Cattle

- Entries are free. Prize Money: 1st \$15 2nd \$10 3rd \$5 and \$50 for Supreme Exhibits.
- Ribbons and trophies for all classes are to be collected during the show.
- **Saturday showing only. Judging commences at 8.30am**
- All cattle can take part in the Grand Parade on Saturday.
- **Beef Cattle & Dexter entries are to be posted to Secretary - PO Box 150 Mudgeeraba Qld 4213**
- Exhibitors must hold \$10 million public liability insurance & provide a certificate of currency with entry form.
- The name of the sire, dam, tattoo number, date of birth and breed must be stated on the entry form.
- The age of cattle must be the actual age on judging day.
- All stock must be registered in their herd book as purebred.
- All cattle must be tick-free and all bona-fide property of the exhibitor.
- All animals being led or paraded on the showground must have strong halters & nose clip or nose ring & lead attachments at all times.
- The cattle must be tractable. Each single exhibit must be tied up with halter and neck chain.
- Any animal shown as an individual cannot be shown with its dam.
- No cattle will be permitted entry without NLIS device.
- All PIC numbers to be given in writing to NLIS reader.
- It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to ensure that the leaders of their stock in judging rings & parades or elsewhere on the grounds are capable of exercising control over the animals in their care.
- The stewards reserve the right to have an animal removed from the judging ring, main arena or other areas, if, in their opinion, such an animal is classed as dangerous, intractable or is disadvantaging other exhibitors.
- Students must be correctly attired to lead cattle (jeans or long pants, dust coats or vests and suitable footwear, such as riding boots are essential.)
