ENTRY CATEGORIES

S = Students - Person attending primary or secondary school
 N = Novice - Less than two (2) years turning experience
 A = Pyrography & Carving - These classes will be judged separate to Woodturning

JM = Junior Member - Student attending the clubs weekly Classes
 O = Open - More than 2 years turning experience

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entries must be certified as the sole work of the entrant.
- Entries must have been completed within the last 12 months.
- Stewards have the right to remove an item which doesn't meet the requirements of the class in the show
- Stewards have the right to remove an item from one class & place it into another class
- **The judges decision is final.**
- All entries attract an entry fee of \$2.
- A maximum of two entries per class per entrant is allowed
- An entry form must be completed listing Category, Class, Wood, Finish and Description of each entry and fee attached.
- All entries must be with the Stewards no later than 2:00pm Wednesday 20th June at the Mudgeraba Show grounds.

Most Successful Points allocated 5 for First, 3 for Second, 1 for Third

One entry per class = 1st = 3 points | Two entries in a class = 1st & 2nd = 3 points for 1st and 1 point for 2nd
 Greater than 2 entries in a class 1st, 2nd and 3rd 1st = 5 Points , 2nd = 3 points , 3rd = 1 point

Judges encouragement in each category S, JM, N, O & A

The Champion Exhibit, Reserve Champion exhibit & Judges encouragement award will be decided from the winners of all of the classes - in that category.

Most Successful Exhibitor in each categories will be decided from the most points obtained in all classes - in their category.

Trophies will be given for Grand Champion, Reserve Champion, Judges Encouragement Award, Most Successful Exhibitor.
