BREEDS: ILLAWARRA / JERSEY / GUERNSEY / HOLSTEINS

RULES & REGULATIONS

All cattle entering Mudgeeraba Showgrounds must be NLIS identified.

1. Entries are free and will close with the Secretary one week prior to the show.
They may be sent to : The Secretary, PO Box 150 Mudgeeraba Qld 4213 or fax 07 5530 6592
2. Grounds are declared Brucellosis free and all cattle must be from "accredited free herds".
3. No cattle will be admitted to the grounds unless thoroughly tractable.
4. The age of exhibits is to be calculated from June 1st.
5. All cows must be breeders and all cows not in milk, not evidently in calf, and must be accompanied by a certificate from the owner or agent to the effect that they have bred within the last two (2) years.
6. No animal in the breeding classes which is not in a healthy breeding state or is incapacitated by excess fat, shall be eligible for a prize.
7. In "Dry" classes, all eligible cattle must be six (6) months in calf or dry.
8. Dairy cattle over six (6) months of age other than those from EBL accredited or certified free herds will require a negative for EBL within six (6) month prior to entry of the show.
9. Judging will commence at 9.00am Saturday. Saturday showing only.
10. Prize money will be given to competitors at the end of judging.
11. Results will be forwarded to the Queensland Country Life, the Land and Dairy Farmer publications.
12. The judge reserves the right to judge in any order deemed necessary.
PRIZE MONEY: 1ST \$25, 2nd \$20, 3rd \$15.
13. Exhibitors must hold \$10 million public liability insurance & provide a certificate of currency with entry form.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING HEALTH CONDITIONS APPLYING TO ALL LIVESTOCK

1. **TUBERCULOSIS** – Cattle must originate from a property classified by the Chief Veterinary Officer of the state of origin as free of Tuberculosis.
2. **BRUCELLOSIS** – Stock permitted entry only from confirmed free, tested negative and monitored herds only.
3. E.B.L. (a) Dairy cattle must originate from herds classified as accredited or certified free – no test required.
(b) Dairy cattle over six (6) months of age other than those from E.B.L. accredited or certified free herds will require a negative (AGID) test for E.B.L. within six (6) months of the show date.
