9. Breeders Group: three animals, both sexes to be presented.

Animals must be owned and bred by the exhibitor. All animals must be entered in the general classes.

12. Bucket fed calf: 1 month to 6 months. Not necessarily purebred.

13. Led Steer or Heifer competition: not necessarily purebred-milk tooth (light weight & heavy weight)

## Regulations for Stud Beef Cattle & Led Steer/Heifer classes

- ENTRIES ARE FREE Prize Money: 1<sup>st</sup> \$25 2<sup>nd</sup> \$15 3<sup>rd</sup> \$10 and \$50 for Supreme Exhibit
- Ribbons and trophies for all classes are to be collected during the show.
- Saturday showing only. Judging commences at 8.30am.
- All cattle can take part in the Grand Parade on Saturday.
- Entries are to be posted to Secretary – PO Box 150 Mudgeeraba Qld 4213
- or emailed to [lawrence.agshows@gmail.com](mailto:lawrence.agshows@gmail.com) by Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2025.
- Exhibitors must hold \$10 m public liability insurance & provide a certificate of currency if required
- The name of sire, dam, tattoo number, date of birth, and breed must be stated on the entry form.
- The age of cattle must be the actual age on judging day.
- All stock must be registered in their herd book as purebred.
- All cattle must be tick-free and all bona-fide property of the exhibitor.
- All animals being led or paraded on the showground must have strong halters & lead attachments at all times and animals over the age of 8 months require a nose dog or nose ring.
- All cattle must be tractable. Each single exhibit must be tied up with halter and neck collar.
- Any animal shown with its dam cannot be shown as an individual.
- No cattle will be permitted entry without NLIS device.
- All PIC numbers to be given in writing to NLIS reader with NVD.
- It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to ensure that the leaders of their stock in judging rings & parades or elsewhere on the grounds are capable of exercising control over the animals in their care.
- The stewards reserve the right to have, if, in their opinion, such an animal is classed as dangerous to the public, intractable or is disadvantaging other exhibitors.
- Students must be correctly attired to lead cattle (jeans or long pants, dust coats or vests and suitable footwear, such as enclosed leather boots are essential).
