

MUDGEERABA SHOW SOCIETY 2026 SITES CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. OPEN AREA SITES are outdoor sites on grass or asphalt. You may use your own tent, marquee, ute, caravan, trailer, van or display. Minimum frontage is 3m. Average depth is 3m. Excess depth (over 4m) will incur an additional fee. Premium sites are located in proximity to the showbags and rides. Corner sites are calculated on per metre frontage ie. a 3m x 3m marquee on a corner site will be charged at 6m frontage.
- 2. HIRED MARQUEE SITES are located outside within the Showgrounds on grass or asphalt. One fully enclosed individual marquee site is $3.5m \times 3.5m$. The marquee is hired by the Society on your behalf and is installed ready for use including one internal light fitting. Premium sites are located in proximity to the showbags and rides.
- 3. APPLICATION & SITE FEES: All Site Applications will be received and considered against selection criteria based on past performance, attraction and/or value for money. Please submit your application as soon as possible, with full details, but please DO NOT make any payment until you receive confirmation that your application is successful. Late site applications will only be considered for approval on merit. Site fees are non-refundable.

If the full remittance is not received by the due date, the Society reserves the right to re-let the site referred to on such terms and conditions as the Society may determine and this contract shall be void and of no effect.

- 4. POWER: One power outlet will be provided for a cost of \$50 (inc GST). The cost of each additional power connection is \$100 (inc GST). Extra power connections will be allocated only if available. All extension leads are to be supplied by the siteholder, and the use of a power board with a safety switch or circuit breaker/board is mandatory for all sites with multiple connections. **Double adaptors are not permitted.** All electrical equipment being used on the Showgrounds must have been tested and tagged by a licenced electrical contractor within the current time frame. Tagging of electrical appliances and extension leads will be checked once on site. This is essential for the safety of all siteholders and the general public and is a requirement of the Workplace Health and Safety Act of 2011. If equipment is found not to be tested and tagged, it will either be done on-site (charges of \$50 (inc GST) per item will apply) or it will not be able to be used.
- 5. PASSES: The site fee for a Trade site includes up to four single one-day entry passes (non-transferable) valid for either Saturday or Sunday. For Community sites, complimentary entry passes are issued subject to committee approval.

 Additional one-day passes will be charged at \$15.00 (inc GST) each. (Limits apply).
- 6. PARKING: Parking at the allocated siteholder carpark (pending confirmation of carpark availability) is included in your site fee and will be subject to capacity limits. You will need to show your siteholder entry pass showing "CP" to obtain access. Parking is not included in additional entry passes. No siteholders will be permitted to park additional vehicles on the grounds during the Show. Any siteholders found to do so will forfeit any future applications.
- 7. INSURANCE: The Show Society requires that each siteholder must carry Public or Legal Liability Insurance.

A Certificate of Currency must be provided with your application and must show the following:

- (i) Policy Number & Expiry Date
- (ii) Type of Business
- (iii) The insured's name must be the same as the name on your site application.
- (iv) The period of insurance must cover the duration of your time on the grounds.
- (v) Public Liability Insurance of \$20,000,000 minimum.
- (vi) Your Certificate of Currency should indicate that your policy covers you at the Mudgeeraba Showgrounds or Anywhere in Australia. PLEASE NOTE: It is the responsibility of the siteholder to ensure that your Public Liability Insurance Policy covers your activities at the Mudgeeraba Showgrounds for the duration of your time on the grounds. A copy of any part of your policy or renewal document cannot be accepted in lieu of a Certificate of Currency.
- 8. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Siteholders must abide by any applicable health directives set down by the Chief Health Officer. Hand sanitizer must be provided for the use of your staff and customers throughout the Show.
- 9. GAS: If your site requires a gas fitout, please provide us with your current Gas Permit, which also needs to be available at the Show. Your Gas Permit must have been issued within twelve months of 2026 Show dates.
- 10. VEHICLES/ACCESS: Access to the site for setup is available from the Wednesday prior to the Show. Your bump-in time will be confirmed by the Site Manager. FAILURE TO ADHERE TO BUMP-IN TIME SLOTS MAY RESULT IN FORFEITING YOUR PREFERRED LOCATION. No setup will be permitted on Saturday morning and no delivery vehicles will be allowed access to the grounds on Saturday or Sunday during Show open times. There will be NO EXCEPTION to this rule due to liability regulations. Siteholders will not be permitted access to their sites until all site fees are paid in full and all required documentation has been received by the Show Manager. The Show Society reserves the right to tow away vehicles parked on the grounds during the Show, at the owner's expense.

Any motor vehicle being driven on the grounds must be comprehensively insured and may only be driven by a person who is licenced to drive that particular class of vehicle. For bump-in, set up and pack down, the vehicle speed limit on the grounds will be strictly no more than 5kph. Hazard lights must be activated.

- 11. FOOD LICENCES AND FOOD VANS: If applicable, food and beverage vendors must be able to produce on demand a current Licence/Registration issued pursuant to the Queensland Food Act 2006, in order to gain admission to the grounds. Food vans must be self-contained, must be registered to the operator and must fulfil all compliance regulations. All cooking oils/fats must be safely removed from the grounds prior to the siteholder departing from the grounds. Waste water tanks will be provided.
- If you have a MOBILE food stall, please provide us with a copy of your current Food Licence for any Council located in Queensland. If you have a food stall (not mobile), please provide us with a copy of your current City of Gold Coast Temporary Food Licence. Prepackaged food must be labelled in accordance with the Food Standards Code.
- 12. SITE AND SELLING RESTRICTIONS: The siteholder must confine his/her business to the purpose accepted on the site application. No selling, canvassing, hawking or distributing of printed material or other matters will be permitted outside the area allocated; penalties include closure of your site and forfeiting of fees paid. Siteholders are not permitted to conduct raffles or to engage in spruiking. Helium balloons are strictly prohibited unless specific prior approval has been granted. Siteholders are prohibited from engaging in price reduction strategies to compete. Original menu prices should be adhered to.
- 13. Siteholders shall, at all times, conduct themselves in an orderly manner whilst on the grounds and shall be responsible for the actions of their employees and volunteers. Verbal and/or physical abuse will not be tolerated and anyone conducting themselves in this manner will be removed from the grounds immediately and will forfeit their site.
- 14. Under the Licensing Act, no alcohol is to be brought onto the grounds. Smoking and/or vaping is not permitted anywhere on the grounds at any time and is prohibited either on or behind your site.
- 15. Microphones, sound amplifiers and machine demonstrations are acceptable only when the level of sound causes no annoyance to the neighbouring stakeholders or the general public. The Society shall be the sole judge as to whether annoyance is being created. In the first instance, such systems shall not be operated without the approval of the Society.
- 16. Siteholders must ensure that they are fully aware of, and that their sites comply with, all regulations and requirements of all statutory bodies. Facepainters, hairbraiders and the like must have a current Working With Children Card.
- 17. Siteholders are required to keep their site tidy and to remove all rubbish (including zip ties) from their site and place it in the skip bins provided.
- 18. Siteholders must keep all advertising signage, flags, banners, display stands and the like within the boundaries of their site. Signage is not to be placed around other parts of the Showgrounds. No part of an exhibitor's display material, tents, pegs, rope, marquees or items for sale etc. are to encroach on another site.
- 19. Siteholders cannot assign or sub-let any part of their site without the consent in writing from the Society.
- 20. Dogs are not permitted on the grounds during the Show without prior approval. Registered assistance dogs excepted (your paperwork will be required).
- 21. Displays, stalls or fixtures may **NOT** be removed or dismantled **before 4pm on the Sunday of the Show**. Every display must be fully staffed and operational during the entire period of the Show, from 8am until 8pm Saturday, and 8am until 4pm Sunday, unless otherwise approved by Mudgeeraba Show Society. Please note Heritage side of the Showgrounds closes down at 5pm on the Saturday of the Show. Vehicles will not be permitted onto the grounds before at least 4.30pm on the Sunday afternoon and will be subject to crowd clearance.
- 22. The Society accepts no liability for the loss of profit, damage to exhibits by loss, deliberate act, theft, fire, water, flood, storm, strikes, riots or any cause whatsoever. Insurance for any loss or damage is the responsibility of the siteholder.
- 23. The Society reserves the right at all times to postpone or amend the advertised dates for the Show, utilising the right only where circumstances necessitate such action, without any liability to the Society.
- 24. Sites shall be allocated relevant to each annual Show and the Society reserves the right to allocate each site each year to whomever it desires. Factors such as years of regular attendance will be taken into account. The Society reserves the right in unforeseen circumstances to amend or alter the exact site or location of any display and the siteholder undertakes to agree to such alterations or re-locations.
- 25. The Society reserves the right to reject any application for a display, site or the right to exhibit at its sole discretion and its decision in this regard shall be final. Furthermore, failing to comply with conditions may result in a siteholder being excluded from future shows.
- 26. The Society reserves the right to cancel and to retain all monies paid in relation thereto if there is or has been, in the opinion of the Committee, any infringement of any part of the foregoing conditions and/or if the siteholder does not occupy the contracted site at the commencement of and during the full period of the Show.
- 27. To enable us to continue to improve the Mudgeeraba Show, siteholders will be asked to complete a survey following the event.
